The Greenwich Police Department is accepting applications for the Fall 2015 Citizen's Police Academy Class. The 6 week session will commence on Monday September 21, 2015 and meet twice a week from 6:30 - 9:00 p.m. \* Graduation will be held on Wednesday November 4, 2015.

The Citizen's Police Academy is a program that provides Greenwich residents with a first hand overview of the law enforcement and community related functions of the Greenwich Police Department.

Instructors for the program will be highly trained and experienced Greenwich Police Officers. There is no fee for the six week program. \*\* Any Greenwich resident 18 years of age or older or any person employed in Greenwich may apply. Seating will be limited to 40 persons.

**Due to the high demand of this class, qualified applicants will be subject to a lottery drawing to determine the class roster if necessary.**
